  - 2. The candidates receiving the highest number of votes in the village at-large election <u>in each separate contest</u> shall be elected.
- 4. No election for a council member seat shall be required if there is only one duly qualified candidate <u>in such contest</u> for the council member seat.

Section 6. Departments; personnel; planning.

(2) PERSONNEL. – Consistent with all applicable state and federal laws, the <u>village manager</u> council shall provide by ordinance for the establishment, regulation, and maintenance of a system governing personnel policies necessary for the effective administration of employees of the village's departments, boards, and agencies.
